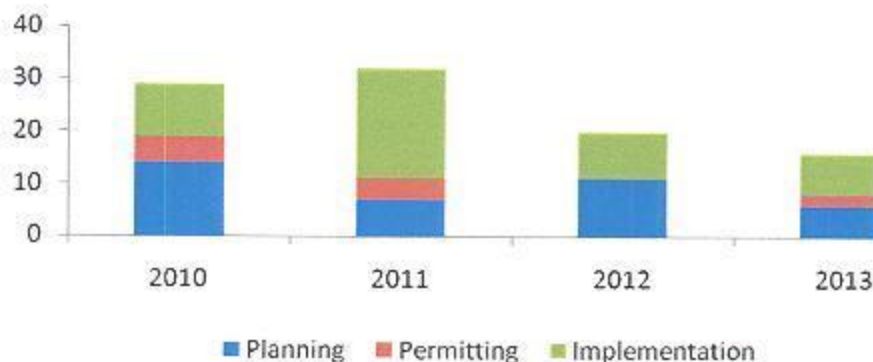

EWPU Update July 2009

1. Upper Columbia Project and Funding Coordination

- Effort to map implementation plans across all sub-basins with available resources in the region
- Needs to reflect current IMW proposal for Entiat



2. 10th SRFB / Tributary Committee Grant Process

- 18 pre-proposals submitted for technical review
- Tours conducted week of June 22
- Presentation workshop with RTT on July 7-8
- Total SRFB allocation = \$1.95M

3. Upper Columbia Congressional Tour August 26-27

- Focus on geographic scale of region; level of coordination and collaboration; and diversity of actions being implemented
- Tour Entiat on 8/26 and Methow on 8/27

4. Status Update and Timing on Transition to Habitat Work Schedule

- All 3 Lead Entities currently using the system (www.hws.ekosystem.us)
- Rolling up to a regional database
 - Used for on-line implementation tracking and reporting
 - "Real time" Upper Columbia implementation schedule
- Mock-up complete in July; Live by this fall
